- All library policies apply to the Teen Space. This includes:
 - No food or beverages.
 - No sound from personal devices (phones, computers, tablets, etc). Always use headphones.
- Speak at a respectful volume. Use “inside voices.”
- All markers, erasers, magnets, and other library property must remain in the space.
- Markers are for use on the whiteboards only.
- This space is for everyone. Please share it considerately. This includes:
 - Allowing others to share the table, couches, and other work surfaces.
 - Ensuring you are using respectful language, both in conversations and on the whiteboard.
 - Keeping all personal displays of affection to a minimum.
