




### **AT THE MAIN LIBRARY :**

**MOTHER GOOSE ON THE LOOSE** (ages 0-18 months with a caregiver): This thirty minute program is designed for babies and toddlers to promote early literacy development. Each session runs for 10 weeks, with a session on Tuesday and Thursday, both at 10:15 am. **Next session begins week of June 10. Registration is required and begins the week of May 27. Registration includes all 10 weeks.**

**TOTS & TALES** (ages 0-3 with a caregiver): A lap-sit story time consisting of age-appropriate rhymes, stories, songs, and other fun literacy building activities. **No registration required.**

**FAMILY STORY TIME** (ages 0-6 with a caregiver): A chance for parents, caregivers, and children to enjoy books, songs, rhymes, and movement activities while developing important early literacy skills. **No registration required.**

**PAJAMA STORY TIME** (all ages): This story time is a great opportunity for working parents and caregivers to attend a story time at the library with their children. Feel free to wear your pajamas! **No registration required.**

**SATURDAY STORIES** (ages 0-6 with a caregiver): Can't make the weekday story times? Join us Saturday mornings! This half-hour story program gives parents, caregivers, and children of all ages the opportunity to enjoy books, songs, rhymes, and movement activities together. **No registration required.**

### **COMMUNITY EVENTS :**

**FOURTEENTH ANNUAL DPW DAY** (all ages): Due to our roof construction project, DPW will be hosting DPW Day this year at the Barn at 159 Camelot Drive.
